## Bauhaus 2.0 – Bauhaus Archiv Berlin App Now Available

When Walter Gropius founded Bauhaus one of his aims was to bring all the various strains of the arts and crafts together in one “building of the future”

In a similar vane the Bauhaus Archiv Berlin have now combined the numerous facets of their work and collections in one technologically advanced, modern construction.

Not a building. But an App.

Available in English and German the Bauhaus Archiv App contains, in addition to over 100 photos of important works by Bauhaus designers, the complete audio tour through the permanent exhibition.

Meaning that you can now visit the Bauhaus Archiv Berlin from wherever you are.

In addition the App provides background introduction on the Archiv Building itself and helpful information for visitors.

If we're honest we do find it a little bit of a shame that it is currently only available for iPad and iPhone. Not least because that means we, troglodytes that we are, can't test it.

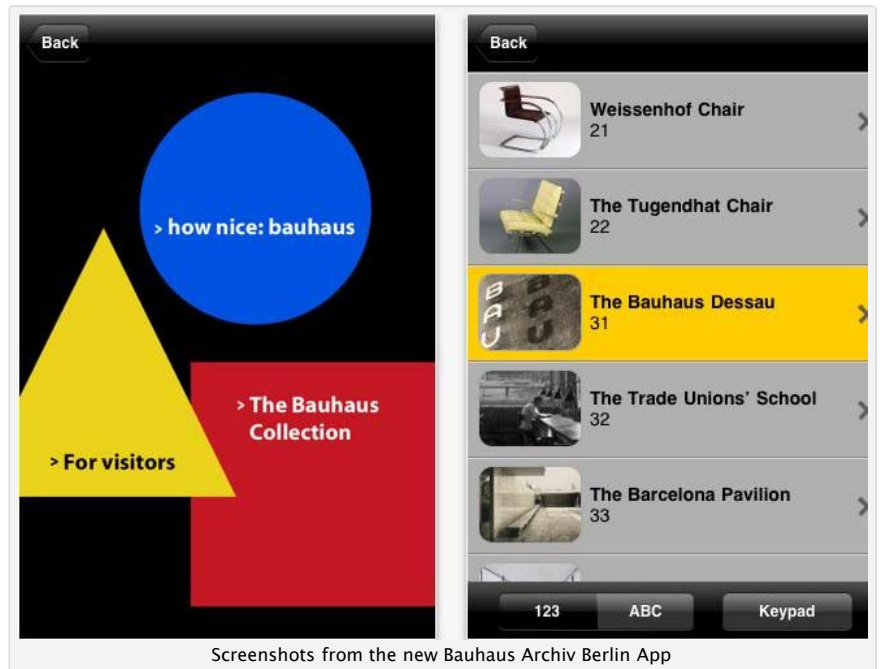
We hope that will change and that in the future it will also be available for other platforms.

However the fact that it is currently only available for apple products does of course lead to the tantalising question of how would the Bauhaus artists and designers have positioned themselves to apple?
